



**Declaration of Intent of the Department of Special Investigation (DSI)  
on Policy of Not Accepting Any Kind of Gifts for the Performance of Duties (No Gift Policy)  
Fiscal Year B.E. 2568 (2025)**

The Department of Special Investigation (DSI) is a government agency responsible for prevention, suppression, investigation and inquiry of criminal offences which must be investigated and inquired by special methods in accordance with the Special Case Investigation law, enforcing the law against special crimes in accordance with the international standard and good governance principle. However, the DSI has become aware that the problem of corruption and misconduct must be urgently corrected and therefore prioritizes the prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct by declaring an action plan for prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct and ensuring that DSI's government officers and staff adhere to the organization's core value "Dignity Specialty Integrity"

Therefore, the DSI would like to show the intention of opposing against all forms of corruption and strengthening moral, ethics, and integrity in performing duties which results in transparency in the performance of duties of personnel in the agency in line with the good governance principle. Hence, the DSI would like to declare the intention to forbid DSI's government officers and staff from requesting or accepting any kind of gifts for the performance of duties (No Gift Policy) — during, before, and after performing such duties — to prevent unfair performance of duties and conflicts of interest and to instill desirable attitudes. The executives and supervisors at all levels must act as a good model and also ensure subordinates' strict observance of the code of conduct.
